


Showcase study: BANAT Region

1. FĂŞANC Rudăria, Caraș Severin C


- Carnival, last feast before a 40 day fast
- Parody of a wedding
- Yearly, first day of Easter Lent
- The entire community (active the youngsters)
- organized by the local community, with the support of the local administration(Mayor and people from cultural centre)
- Tradition





2. JOIMARI Ciclova Română, Caraș Severin


- Women light fires at the cemetery
- pomana for the dead
- On Thursday, before Easter
- The entire community, women especially, older women in particular
- *Natural* organization
- Compulsory, tradition, respecting the dead





3. Prospective research Gărâna, Caraș Severin

- identifying the local memory keepers
- 28 Germans (old people)
- Bohemian origins, XVIII century
- Massively migrated to Germany in the 90s (Stuttgart)



4. KIRCHWEIH Gărâna, Caraș Severin

- Saint patron of the local church (Teresa de Avila, 15Th of October)
- last feast before Advent
- The local community, foreigners, people who return home as tourist (locals who migrated to Germany), tourists From Caraş and Timiş counties)
- Organised by an NGO from Arad (Banatja)
- Participants from Arad
- Locals old, few
- Tourism, entertainment, economic, identity issues





5. GRAPES FESTIVAL Vârșet, Serbia

- Harvest celebration (vineyard) and popular costumes parade
- 14 16 September
- Locals, tourists from nearby areas
- Mayor organises
- Tourist, economic purpose





6. KERWEI Becicherecul Mic, Timiș

- Saint patron of the local church (Martin of Tours, 11th of November)
- last feast before Advent
- The members of the dancing team (youngsters), families and friends, the 'Germans'
- Organised by Karin Lauer (German origin)
- re-invented after a 20 year break on family level
